The **Clayton Cameron Memorial Bursary** is given to a graduating grade 12 student who has demonstrated strong leadership and volunteering in the area of children/youth at Sunset Community Centre.

Clayton Cameron was a coordinator at Sunset Community Centre. He, with members of the Sunset Community, was instrumental in re-establishing the non-profit Sunset Community Association in 1986. Mr. Cameron died very shortly after retiring. It is in his memory this award is presented.

The bursary is intended to assist students desiring a post-secondary education. **\$500 will be released, via cheque, upon proof of registration from a recognized post-secondary institution.** Proof of registration must be received by December 31st. 2021.

- An autobiographical account of volunteer experiences in maximum two pages, 11pt. Calibri font, double spaced.
